The Woodtick Wheelers are coordinating with The Minnesota Department of Natural Resources and Cass County Minnesota Sherriff's department, to host three MN DNR-certified **ATV Youth Safety Classes in 2023**. This training consists of a class with hands on training.

Proposed dates:

Saturday May 6th 1 class -morning

Saturday June 10th - 1 class - morning and 1 class afternoon

Once scheduled these classes will be confirmed and promoted .

Requirements to attend the class: Must be 10 years of age and have completed the online course before class start dates listed above in order to be eligible to take this class. Must print completion voucher and bring to class.

If any club members have children or grandchildren ages 10 – 15 encourage them to enroll in the ATV online safety training class, visit www.dnr.state.mn.us/safety/vehicle/atv/index.html#calendar.

Also anyone born after July 1, 1987, or who is 16 years or older must complete the ATV safety online course to be able to utilize MN DNR Grant In Aid Trails.
