**Just in** - Woodtick Wheelers club members that are part of the Cass County Search & Rescue Team participated in a search for a missing person conducted by the Cass County Sheriff's Department

Craig Wadzink Club Vice President/Safety Officer and S&R team member, sent this email to Woodtick Wheeler S&R Team Leader Sherrie Gayken.

Sherrie, Scott provided a nice recap of the first day of the search. I do not know if he took photos of the gathering. Unfortunately, I did not take any photos on Wednesday of the search due to many moving parts in preparation for the start of the search teams and missed the opportunity.

On Wednesday, we regrouped in another location with the Sheriff's Command Trailer, more organized. There were 6 or more machines from our SAR team. Chad again was lead coordinator, and there was significant involvement by many Sheriff's Deputies, Chief Deputy, Sheriff Welk and a Detective as well close to a dozen volunteer firefighters from the Walker Fire and Rescue Dept. Less than 45 minutes into the search the missing women was found alive off of the Heartland trail southwest of Long Lake, north of Hwy 34. Good ending to the search.

At the close of the search on Tuesday, Chad and the Sheriff expressed to me that there was a great response time from the SAR team and the search procedures were followed perfectly. I again received excellent comments from both of them on Wednesday on our SAR team.
